Our focus is on developing positive aspects of inheritance, and reducing traumatic aspects, such as: adverse childhood experiences, domestic and sexual abuse, addiction, anxiety, despair, grief, depression, attachment issues, survival coping mechanisms, stress biasing, adoption, war related trauma, genocide, ethnocide, immigration, and removal from traditional homelands.

Genetics, epigenetics, biogenealogy, cultural recovery, spiritual alignment, *My Body, My Breath* techniques, and neurobiological resourcing will be discussed.
